

## INSIDE/OUT

Genre: Crime Action

Ten years inside didn't ruin Dursey... it made him smarter.

Logline: A top cop hooks up with the jail gangs out for revenge on the dirty cops and Chicago mob boss running for Mayor by wiping out mass electronic records to clear his name.

Framed for murder Officer Dursey has the respect of Italian mafia boss Lucchi Sr. that Dursey put away. Upon his release ten years later, Dursey sets up a business funded by Lucchi before recruiting from the gangs; Jamaican, skinheads, Asian racers and a biker with a mech-tech. Dursey proves his right to lead. Only the greedy Asian Lord leaves, his little sister Eriki is behind and with Dursey all the way.

When Lucchi Jr's paid off cops Smolinski and Patterson try to nail Dursey with smuggling, Eriki has Smolinski's car bugged to ruin Lucchi Jr. before he becomes Mayor. When they get the 143<sup>rd</sup> Precinct contract, it throws suspicion on Smolinski's fury as their plan builds around the station, morgue and courtrooms in the guise of recycling.

Smolinski and partner are with Lucchi Jr. when his cougar step-mom calls him down. He has her driver/ boy toy murdered. As they go in, Squee's sister tips off Yan, still, the electronic records are destroyed and Dursey plants choice records while the 143<sup>rd</sup> scrambles in the dark and Eriki's car goes remote and divides Yan's forces, which are overwhelmed by reinforcements.

"INSIDE/OUT" is an action in the vein of the Specialist where two wrongs sometimes do make a right.
