

RELAYERS: PILOT EPISODE: JENGHIS GONE

Genre: Science Fiction - one-hour series

TAGLINE: World history, the do over.

LOGLINE: Wracked by war destruction and chemical storms, Earth's last survivors only hope to step foot on the planet again is to go back in time from their null space station in 2030 to change history.

Prey to chemical storms, only one of two last shuttles of survivors gets to the sphere protected by a null zone above chaotic Earth. The first jump to Mongolia 1170 A.D. is set up by Book, an old man that can link into the world data computer.

Lead by Aydin Ata, a blood descendant of Jenghis Khan, the Relayer team steps up to the tall transfer crystals. A drop of his blood and the team levitates before they disappear.

Landing on the early winter Mongolian Steppes, the Relayer's set off to find the child Temujin (Jenghis Khan). They befriend Serkan, his son and daughter enroute. At a mountain lake the team is welcomed into the winter village, where three-year-old Temujin finds Aydin.

Horrified by the killer her son would become, Temujin's mother chooses to join him in the otherworld to protect him. Aydin starts to change while the team sneaks away with horses. A deadly chase is on as the village raises the alarm.

The team barely cross into the jump zone before Serkan, his son and two others catch up wielding whips as the Relayers disappear. Aydin wakes in the med center, his unexpected changes leave him with new old scars and old scars gone.
