

THUNDER WARRIOR

Genre: Sci Fi Thriller

Logline: History repeats when a girl is forced to protect her big brother from their family's otherworldly legacy.

Grandmother Lena Frinz's superstitious recall of her fiancé's disappearance in a flash of lightning during the 1910 drought infects her early teen granddaughter Haley so much she tells her friends Josh and Chucky. Chucky assumes the Shop Owner's son Marvin has been called to the storm and the two boys follow him.

Haley also chases her brother Thom at the same time to Douglas' dam, which throttles the creek in the 1930's drought.

As Marvin punches a hole in the dam, he stops and trudges through drought dead field and bush. As the boys give chase, behind them, Thom goes zombie-like and Haley can't stop him.

In a ravine, terrified and surrounded by lightning, Marvin disappears.

Josh and Chucky tackle Thom, but when a suited alien comes out of the lightening, the three drag Thom away. Distance returns Thom to mind, his only chance is to be the bait for his little sister's ambush.

When the alien finds them and damage to his helmet breaks his control over Thom. Thom stops breathing to be revived by the alien. Terrified into action, Chucky cracks open the alien's helmet with a rock. Thom and Haley stare at eyes like theirs before the creature disintegrates.

With the alien buried in the creek bed, the dam bursts and they leave with a chunk of the alien's helmet.
